	General	Evidence Available
NICEIC Scheme Rule 5, 6, 7	A minimum of 2 projects, with all relevant documentation and certification are available for review. The projects include work carried out by the organisation covering the scope of certification applied for i.e. design, installation, commissioning and maintenance. Access to the project sites has been confirmed with the customer and they understand the depth of testing and inspection required by the assessment. Sites are within 30 minutes travelling time of the office.	
NICEIC Scheme Rule 5	A Principal Duty Holder, Sufficient Designer(s) and Key Responsible Person(s) are in place and will be available as required throughout the assessment.	
BAFE Scheme Clause 12 (12.1- 12.10) & SG1	Module 1 - System Design This section is only applicable to businesses who are wanting design to be within the scope of their certification.	
BAFE Scheme Clause 13 (13.1- 13.8) & SG1	Module 2 - Installation This section is only applicable to businesses who are wanting installation to be within the scope of their certification.	
BAFE Scheme Clause 14 (14.1- 14.11) & SG1	Module 3 - Commissioning and Handover This section is only applicable to businesses who are wanting commissioning and handover to be within the scope of their certification.	
BAFE Scheme Clause 15 (15.1- 15.15) & SG1	Module 4 - Maintenance This section is only applicable to businesses who are wanting maintenance to be within the scope of their certification.	
BAFE Scheme Clause 16 (16.1- 16.11) & SG1	System Verification Organisations wishing to undertake Verification will need to have Design included within their scope of certification.	

Clause 10 (10a-10n)	Management Systems It is a scheme requirement that businesses have a documented management system (Business Operation Manual). The management system shall include the items details within the section as a minimum.	
Clause 6 (6.1-6.6) & SG1	Certification Audit All applicants shall have available for assessment the items listed in this section.
